WORLD-RENOWNED EQUESTRIAN and Olympian, Steffen Peters is Chalk Hill's Clinician and Trainer. In his native Germany, he was introduced to the equestrian arena by his sister, and his burgeoning interest was encouraged by his very supportive parents. A chance meeting with some riders from San Diego, attending a clinic in Germany, planted in Steffen the yen for travel. Armed with an invitation to visit them, he came to the United States in 1984. After a brief return to Germany for his required military service, he came to San Diego to take up his career, traveling from stable to stable (like Michael Parks in *Then Came Bronson*), simultaneously riding both his motorcycle and his saddle.

His connection to Chalk Hill started in 1995 at a training clinic in San Diego. It was suggested to him that he visit Chalk Hill and a meeting with Mr. Furth quickly turned into an invitation to join the Chalk Hill equestrian program, an opportunity not to be missed! Of the Chalk Hill Pavilion, Steffen says, "I have traveled the world and I have never seen such a facility. Its size, grandeur and beauty are second-to-none and the arena footing, so important to a horse's performance, is the best in the world!"

Currently he is training Lord Chalk Hill. "His magnificence, temperament and refinement combine to make him an unflappable performer." ~
